

US Army Corps Studies 1931 & 1941

Study is no longer published but information is available from the US Army Corps of Chicago, Illinois.

The Army Corps of Engineers study in 1931 and 1941 was an attempt to measure the sand build up down stream from the Grand Marsh drainage project. They noted large deposits of sand had been deposited in the Momence area due to channel erosion upstream in Indiana. They repeated this study in 1941 and found that the sand deposits had greatly increased and covered a further reach downstream.
